Earliest to Pick. Season extender. Fruit size: average. Colour medium to dark red. Firmness Good. Excellent flavor, Good production				
Honeoye Earliest July 6 -15 in Edmonton	*	\$173	\$173	

Mid-early variety (10 days ahead of Kent as a season extender) with superior yield and appearance. Fruit: 30 gm. Very pretty glossy berry, flavor more like a wild strawberry. Ripens from the top down, white tip is 3 days away from being ripe - useful indicator for u-pickers. Can be bitter on sandy soils.

Fruit very dense and juicy, excellent flavour Ready after Kent is finished and after Valley Sunset starts around August 15 in Edmonton - to extend your season. Soft skin, firm flesh. Flavour notes: Tastes a bit like a raisin. Interesting variety. Not as cold hardy as Kent. will winterkill below on -40 to -50 years. zone 3 -4. Red Steel Resistance.

Most popular commercial U-pick variety in Alberta. Everbearing type of strawberry, fruit is large, firm, fairly sweet mild flavour, conical to round in shape, glossy red colour, bright red on inside, popular for commercial production. Susceptible to powdery mildew. Red Steele Resistance.

Everbearing type of strawberry, fruit is large, 30-50 gm, carmine red, glossy, very firm, good sweet flavour, long conical in shape. Flavour is sweet, but not cloying, with a spicy sourness. Susceptible to powdery mildew. Not as hardy as Seascape. Must protect with straw - zone 3 *

30-40 gm Berry, Dark Red Glossy, Very Good Firmness. Offers a balance between productivity and berry size, with excellent flavor and a firm texture. Production cycle between Albion and Seascape to extend picking season. Susceptible to powdery mildew. Zone 3 *
